DISCUSSION: The recommendation is not to increase tuition and fees for

Fall 2025. The Board is committed to providing highquality education while offering low-cost tuition. Affordable tuition assists student debt concerns, maintains stability in

enrollment, and attracts additional students.

DISTRICT PRESIDENT'S RECOMMENDATION:

The District President recommends the current tuition rates and fees remain at \$67 per credit hour for in-district residents, \$127 per credit hour for out-of-district residents, and \$202 per credit hour for out-of-state/out-of-country residents, effective Fall 2025. No tuition increase is recommended.

SUGGESTED MOTION: "Mr. Chairman, I make a motion that the Board of Trustees

of Collin County Community College District approves the current tuition rates and fees of \$67 per credit hour for indistrict residents, \$127 per credit hour for out-of-district residents, and \$202 per credit hour for out-of-state/out-of-country residents, to remain effective Fall 2025. There

will not be an increase in tuition."
