NEW! Pre-School Academy

The Pre-School Academy is designed to help children grow academically and physically. Children will discover that learning is fun at this academy, where they will follow the State of Texas Pre-School Curriculum that includes: math skills, language development, physical education/motor skill development, music, art and other enrichment skills.

- The Academy is for 3-year-olds and 4-year-olds, whose parents are willing to pay tuition.
- The Academy is open to 3- and 4-year-olds whose birthday is on or before Sept. 1.
- Parents have option to choose a half-day or full-day program.



PPCD

(Pre-School Program for Children with Disabilities)

PPCD is a special education program that serves children – between the ages of three and five – who have delays in speech, language or physical, social and/or emotional development.

- Students are eligible to enroll in this program at no cost to the family on their third birthday.
- PPCD Bilingual (Spanish) classrooms are provided when necessary. The amount and type of services provided to students are determined by an Individual Education Program (IEP) committee.



Pre-Kindergarten

Pre-Kindergarten is a state-funded, half-day program that follows the State of Texas Pre-School curriculum that includes language development, math skills, physical education/motor skill development, music, art and other skills to help prepare them for success in school. This program serves children who are **three**- or **four-years-old** and whose birthday falls on or before Sept. 1. Students may attend this program **free of charge** if they meet any of the following criteria:

- · is limited English speaking.
- qualifies for free or reduced lunch.
- is an active military dependent.
- · has been with Dept. of Family and Protective Services.
- is homeless.

ESL/Bilingual Pre-Kindergarten

(English as a Second Language)

ESL/Bilingual Pre-Kindergarten is part of the state-funded, half-day Pre-Kindergarten program that works




on their English language proficiency to prepare them for success in school.

Students may attend this program *free of charge* if they meet this criteria:

- is limited English speaking.
- must be three- or fouryears-old with a birthday on or before Sept. 1

Cost of Programs



Full-Day Pre-School Academy

- \$600 per month, for 10 months
- \$75 registration fee
- \$30 supply fee (per semester)

Half-Day Pre-School Academy

- \$340 per month, for 10 months
- \$60 registration fee
- \$25 supply fee (per semester)

Pre-Kindergarten/ESL-Bilingual Pre-K

· Free to students who qualify

· Free to students who qualify

Note: *Those students who qualify for a half-day Pre-K program and want to attend all-day sessions may do so by paying a fee established by the state - for the other half-day session- plus \$60 registration fee and \$25 per semester for supplies.
