C. Strategic Objective, Goal, or Need Addressed:

Ratify the use of an interlocal agreement (purchasing cooperative) as the delivery method of the pavement project.

D. Summary:

Board policy CV (LOCAL) states the Board "shall determine the project delivery / contract award method to be used for each construction contract valued at or above \$50,000. To assist the Board, the Superintendent shall recommend the project delivery / contract award method that he or she determines provides the best value to the district."

The pavement / parking lot outside of the welding lab and band hall needs to be updated to prevent flooding and accommodate deliveries to the welding lab. The project is expected to cost over \$50,000. The Superintendent has determined a purchasing cooperative is the best method to procure this service.

A purchasing cooperative allows the district to use a co-op vendor as services have already been competitively procured. The Board of Trustees previously allowed district administration the ability to use a co-op or a CSP. This action will ratify the use of a co-op.

G. Administrative Recommendation:

Administration recommends the Board of Trustees ratify the use of an interlocal agreement as the delivery method for the procurement of construction services for the Robstown Early College High School Pavement Project.
