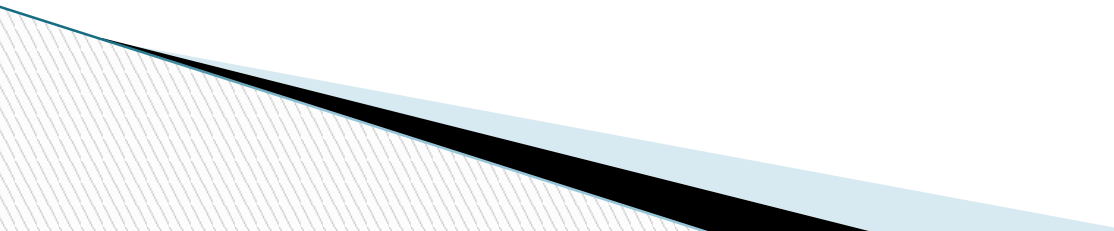
# What is SIG

- ▶ Grant from Federal Government to the State
  - ▶ Grant from State to the School District
  - ▶ Schools Most in Need
  - ▶ To Substantially Raise Student Achievement

# Transformational Model

- ▶ Develop and Increase Teacher and School Leader Effectiveness
  - ▶ Comprehensive Instructional Strategies
  - ▶ Increasing Learning Time and Creating Community Oriented Schools
  - ▶ Providing Operational Flexibility and Sustained Support

# Teacher and Leader Effectiveness

- ▶ Rigorous, Transparent, and Equitable Evaluation and Support Systems
  - ▶ Identify Teachers and Leaders Who Have Increased Student Achievement and Those Who Have Not
  - ▶ Implement Strategies to Recruit, Place and Retain Staff

# Instruction Reform Strategies

- ▶ Use Data To Identify and Implement a Research-based Instructional Program
  - ▶ Promote Continuous Use of Student Data
  - ▶ Provide Staff Ongoing, High Quality, Job-embedded Professional Development
  - ▶ Implement School Wide “Response-to-Intervention” Model
  - ▶ Provide Supports and Professional Development to Implement Effective Strategies to Support Students with Disabilities in the Least Restrictive Environment

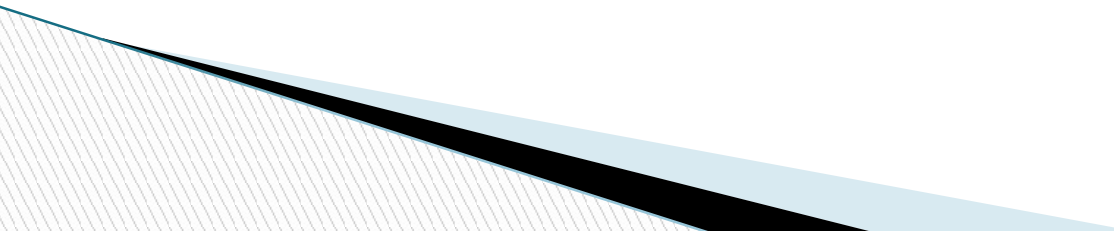
# Increasing Learning Time

- ▶ Establish Schedules and Strategies That Provide Increased Learning Time
  - ▶ Provide Ongoing Mechanisms for Family and Community Engagement
  - ▶ Partner with Parents and Organizations to Meet Students' Social, Emotional, and Health Needs
  - ▶ Implement Systems Such as Positive Behavioral Supports, Reduce Bullying and Student Harassment
  - ▶ Expand the School Program to Include Pre-Kindergarten

# Operational Flexibility

- ▶ Give Schools Operational Flexibility (Staffing, Calendars/Time, and Budgeting)
  - ▶ Provide Ongoing Support from the District and State

# Timeline

# Budget

- ▶ Up To \$2,000,000 per Year for Up To 5 Years
  - ▶ We Anticipate a Budget of \$200,000 to \$500,000 per Year for 5 Years
