- Grant from State to the School District
- Schools Most in Need
- To Substantially Raise Student Achievement

Transformational Model

- Develop and Increase Teacher and School Leader Effectiveness
- Comprehensive Instructional Strategies
- Increasing Learning Time and Creating Community Oriented Schools
- Providing Operational Flexibility and Sustained Support

Teacher and Leader Effectiveness

- Rigorous, Transparent, and Equitable Evaluation and Support Systems
- Identify Teachers and Leaders Who Have Increased Student Achievement and Those Who Have Not
- Implement Strategies to Recruit, Place and Retain Staff

Instruction Reform Strategies

- Use Data To Identify and Implement a Researchbased Instructional Program
- Promote Continuous Use of Student Data
- Provide Staff Ongoing, High Quality, Jobembedded Professional Development
- Implement School Wide "Response-to-Intervention" Model

Provide Supports and Professional Development to Implement Effective Strategies to Support Students with Disabilities in the Least Restrictive Environment

Increasing Learning Time

- Establish Schedules and Strategies That Provide Increased Learning Time
- Provide Ongoing Mechanisms for Family and Community Engagement
- Partner with Parents and Organizations to Meet Students' Social, Emotional, and Health Needs

- Expand the School Program to Include Pre-Kindergarten

Operational Flexibility

- Give Schools Operational Flexibility (Staffing, Calendars/Time, and Budgeting)
- Provide Ongoing Support from the District and State

Budget

- ▶ Up To \$2,000,000 per Year for Up To 5 Years
