Letters of interest must be received in the Superintendent's Office by Tuesday, June 16, 2020 at 1:00 PM. Candidates will be contacted once the Special Meeting date has been finalized for interviews.

The Board of Education will appoint a candidate to School Board Seat C directly after interviews and will serve until the next regular election on October 6, 2020. The deadline to fill the Seat C vacancy is July 2, 2020.

Please include your contact information i.e. Phone and Email, education related history and involvement, applicant signature, and date.

Under Board Bylaw 9223, Board Vacancies, the School Board shall declare a vacancy on the Board and shall be filled within thirty (30) days of the vacancy by a Board appointment. The person appointed shall hold office until the next regularly scheduled election for district Board members and shall be afforded all the powers and duties of a Board member upon appointment.

To qualify, applicants for Board membership must comply with applicable borough and state requirements for candidacy to hold office. Under the North Slope Borough Code of Ordinances Section 3.030, Qualifications, under subsection a, the applicant must be "a person who has been a resident of the borough at least six months prior to the date of the election in which he is a candidate eligible to be a Board member." Subsection b states, that no member "may hold any other compensated office or employment, or elected partisan political office, while serving..." Subsection c states, the "member shall be a resident of the district to which the member's seat is assigned at the time of the member's appointment." Subsection d states, the "member who ceases to be a resident of the district to which the member's seat is assigned immediately forfeits his/her office."
