Impact of this Action	In keeping alignment with the state's 60x30 TX goal, the School Finance Commission recommended establishing a PreK through 12 th grade goal of at least 60 percent proficiency at TEA's "Meets" standard at two key "checkpoints" along the state public PreK through 12 th grade educational continuum: • Sixty percent of all students meeting the state's "Meets" standard at third grade reading.
	Sixty percent of all high school seniors graduating without the need for remediation and achieving (1) an industry-accepted certificate aligned with a living wage job; or (2) enrolling in a post-secondary education; or (3) enrolling in the military.
