TASB POLICY UPDATE 90 June 21, 2011

LOCAL POLICIES

BBI – BOARD MEMBERS TECHNOLOGY RESOURCE AND ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATIONS - This policy requires School Board Members to sign an "Acceptable Use Policy" that states that they agree to follow the rules if they uses school issued electronic equipment. This is monitored by the Superintendent.

CQ – TECHNOLOGY RESOURCES – This policy broadens the scope to cover District electronic communications systems and district-issued equipment. Schools are required to install a filtering system and members of the public are subject to monitoring by district staff to ensure appropriate use. This policy also addresses the requirement that electronic records are retained whether created or maintained on the District's technology resource or on personal equipment.

CY – INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY – If an employee creates a work on his or her own time with persona equipment and materials it is called EMPLOYEE OWNERSHIP. The employee must get special permission to use district materials or equipment for the employee's creative project. The policy also explains the District's ability to enter into and agreement for a WORKS MADE FOR HIRE project. There are also provisions requiring the RETURN OF INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY upon termination of a person's association with the district.

EFE – INSTRUCTIONAL RESOURCES COPYRIGHTED MATERIAL - This policy has been moved to CY (LOCAL).

EI – ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT – Students entering grade 9 in the 2011-12 school year must achieve certain scores on the end-of-course assessments in order to graduate. Students in grade 10 during the 2011-12 school year must still pass the "exit-level" TAKS tests. This policy changes the terminology from to "exit-level" testing to "state" testing requirements.

EIA – ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT GRADING/PROGRESS REPORTS TO PARENTS, EIC – ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT CLASS RANKING, EIE – ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT RETENTION AND PROMOTION – The administrators are working on these policies and will have a recommendation soon.

FMH – STUDENT ACTIVITIES COMMENCEMENT – The new policy replaces "exit-level" testing with "state" testing.

FNC – STUDENT RIGHT AND RESPONSIBILITIES STUDENT CONDUCT – Editorial changes have been made to BEHAVIORAL STANDARDS to address the use of personal telecommunications devices and other electronic devices. FNCE – STUDENT CONDUCT – PERSONAL TELECOMMUNICATION ELECTRONIC DEVICES – This policy deals with "personal" telecommunications devises to differentiate between those devises and district-owned devices.
