## 203.2 ORDER OF THE REGULAR SCHOOL BOARD MEETING

### I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to ensure consistency in the order of business at regular school board meetings.

### II. GENERAL STATEMENT OF POLICY

It is the policy of the school board to consider matters that come before it in a consistent and orderly manner.

# III. ORDER

- A. The school board shall conduct an orderly school board meeting. The school board will, at all regular school board meetings, follow an agenda order similar to:
  - 1. Roll Call
  - 2. Pledge of Allegiance
  - 3. Approval of the Agenda
  - 4. Reading and approving minutes
  - 5. School and Community Recognition
  - 6. Audience
  - 7. Reading communications, petitions, etc.
  - 8. Report of the Superintendent
  - 9. Report of standing committees:
    - a. Education Committee
    - b. Human & Community Resources Committee
    - c. Business Committee
  - 10. Special Resolutions
  - 11. Questions/Other
  - 12. Adjournment
- B. Items in this order may be considered as part of a consent agenda.
- C. The school board may depart from the order of business with the consent of the majority of members present.
