# **BOARD CONSENT AGENDA ITEM Board of Trustees Meeting July 25, 2023**

Consider Approval of 2023 – 2024 Expedited and General State Waivers

#### SUMMARY:

This consent agenda item requests approval to apply for the Expedited and General State Waivers listed below for the 2023 - 2024 school year. It is important to note that some of these waivers, if approved, will cover multiple years.

The following Expedited State Waivers are being submitted for consent:

- <u>Staff Development Waiver</u>: the *Staff Development Minutes Waiver* provides for a maximum of 2,100 total waiver minutes to use for professional development for districts and charter schools that provide operational and instructional minutes.
- Modified Schedule/State Assessment Testing Days: This waiver allows the district to modify
  the schedule of classes for students who are not being tested to report to and attend school
  after the state assessment testing period has ended, therefore reducing the interruptions during
  testing periods.
- <u>Teacher Data Portal of the Texas Assessment Management System</u>: Districts that are interested in fulfilling the requirement of TEC, §32.258 to provide teacher access to student assessment data through a local student data system must apply for an expedited waiver.

The following General State Waiver is being submitted for consent:

• Foreign Exchange Student (Less than Five): This waiver allows districts to limit the number of foreign exchange students to five or less per high school.
