Texas English Language Proficiency Assessment System (TELPAS)

Components

- Grades K-1: Holistically rated observations
- Grades 2-12
 - 1. Multiply choice online reading tests in clusters
 - 2. Holistically rated student writing collections
 - 3. Holistically rated observational assessments of listening and speaking

Eligibility

- All K-12 identified ELL
 - 1. ARD Decision
 - 2. Newly enrolled ELLs

Rater Credentials

- Have student in class
- Hold valid education credentials
- Be appropriately trained
- Rate student in all eligible language domains

Overview of Rating and Reporting Process

- Assess language proficiency and assign one of four ratings-use PLDs
- Record students' ratings and related information on TELPAS Student Rating Roster in Appendix B

Assembling of 2-12 Writing Collections

- Must contain at least 5 writing samples and should be done after Feb 18, 2013
- Should reflect student's current proficiency level
- Writing collections must be verified by individual to ensure appropriate types and number selected
- Must be attached to Cover Sheet and maintained for 2 years in permanent folders

Online Training Components

- Basic training for new raters (K-1, 2-12)-required to complete independently
- Online calibration for new and returning raters
 - 1. Grade clusters: K-1, 2, 3-5, 6-8, 9-12
 - 2. Must be completed by end of 2nd calibration set
 - 3. May complete a variety of rating activities as a warming-up exercise

- 4. After submitting your ratings, you will be able to view score

TELPAS Reading

- Assessed through online multiple-choice test consisting of 6 grade cluster tests: 2, 3, 4-5, 6-7, 8-9. 10-12
- Tests are not timed but must be completed on same day
- Accommodations are available
