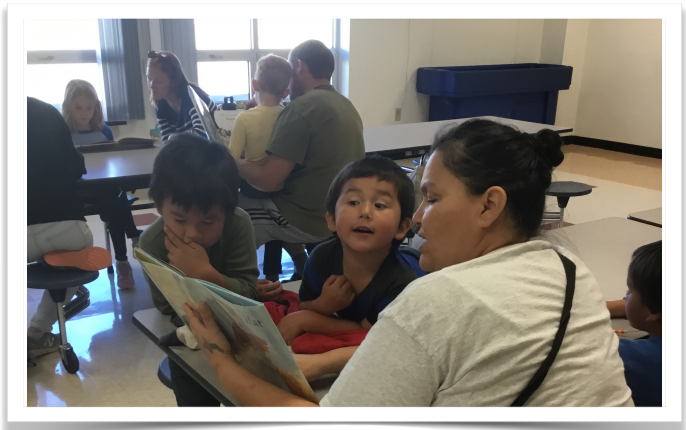


SLT
