Enrollment is down to 198 at the high school campus.

Attendance is up slightly to 95.16% as a campus. This is a decent rebound from our recent flu season. The Freshmen have really been carrying our attendance. We will also be holding an Attendance Committee meeting this week to discuss Course Credit, Credit Recovery, Attendance

Recovery, Parent Meetings, and Summer School. Our next meeting will invite parents to attend so that we may discuss the previously mentioned possibilities.

TAKS/EOC Tutorials – We had our first Saturday TAKS/EOC tutorials on April 6. We will hold four more sessions: April 13, 20, 27 and May 4. Mr. Youngblood, Coach Moseley, Mrs. Smith, Coach Tandy, Coach Clayton and I worked with students to improve their skills in order to increase their achievement possibilities for their upcoming tests. We invited students by sending letters, well in advance, to those students that have not been successful on previous examinations. We also invited any and all students that wished to attend to improve their skills. We had the following number of students attend a session in: Biology EOC - four, World Geography EOC – six, TAKS Science – three, and TAKS Math – six. We have also been encouraging students to attend our after school TAKS/EOC tutorial sessions as well. We have STRONGLY encouraged our remaining six seniors that have not passed the EXIT TAKS in Science and/or Mathematics to attend all sessions. We have four seniors that haven't passed the Math EXIT TAKS and three that have not passed the Science EXIT TAKS.

Semester Exams will be the last three days of the semester except for seniors. Seniors will take theirs a day early to allow teachers time to grade, ensure readiness for graduation and allow time for graduation practice. Teachers are preparing those now for review.

SLR – Our math team is working on our Student Level Review as an ongoing data file for school improvement purposes. We must input cycle grades and benchmark scores for OHS Math students each six weeks and turn this in to TEA.

Senior meetings – We continue to have a few seniors in danger of not graduating; therefore, we have set up parent/student/teacher/counselor/principal meetings each 3 weeks to monitor these individuals. We are continuing to monitor and meet as needed.

Driver Education continues to be taught by Coach Tandy each morning at 6:30 am. through May 17. Driving will occur this summer. He has also made arrangements to take the students to Angelo as a group to test.

One Act Play – Had their final performance in the OHS auditorium as a community performance on Sunday April 7.
