SUMMARY:

This item requests approval to extend the RFP #170615 Security Services award to Investigation Technologies, Inc dba International Investigators for a term of two years.

BOARD GOAL:

VI. Growth, Change & Fiscal Responsibility... demonstrate effective and efficient management of district resources.

PREVIOUS BOARD ACTION:

The proposal was approved on June 27, 2017 for a term of two years with an option to extend for two (2) additional two (2) year terms, upon governing body approval.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The District's current contract expires on June 30, 2019.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES:

RFP #170615 Security Services was evaluated by a committee composed of members from our Maintenance, Risk Management, and Purchasing department. The original recommendation for award was based on two factors; the vendor's history with the district and the K-12 experience of the company.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:

This contract will be paid from the existing Maintenance Department budget. Any overtime for the daytime officers will be paid from the campus budget that requires the overtime.

BENEFIT OF ACTION:

Passage will allow for continued security services for the district.

SUPERINTENDENT'S RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the award to Investigation Technologies, Inc dba International Investigators be extended for a term of two years, July 1, 2019 - June 30, 2021, with one (1) remaining option to extend for an additional two (2) year term with governing body approval.
