		■ The first IRI (Idaho Reading Indicator) testing was performed during the week of September 4th. This test is given the first week of each month, and Istation is also used for student RtI. The data from the IRI using the Istation computer program was gathered and evaluated during grade level PLC weekly meetings.	

After completing the testing, each student was given a proficiency tier of a 1, 2, or 3. Depending on the tier, the students are provided with additional intervention depending on the proficiency tier rating. The Thirkill Elementary staff received staff training on the Istation on August 22, 2018 from Istation representatives. The Thirkill Elementary staff did a collaborative training on the different uses of Isation on October 4, 2018. Additional data discovery training was given to five Thirkill Elementary staff members on October 9, 2018. This training was delivered by both the Idaho State Department of Education and Istation representatives. 60 computer tablets were purchased and designated for the two kindergarten classes are being used for both IRI testing and intervention.
