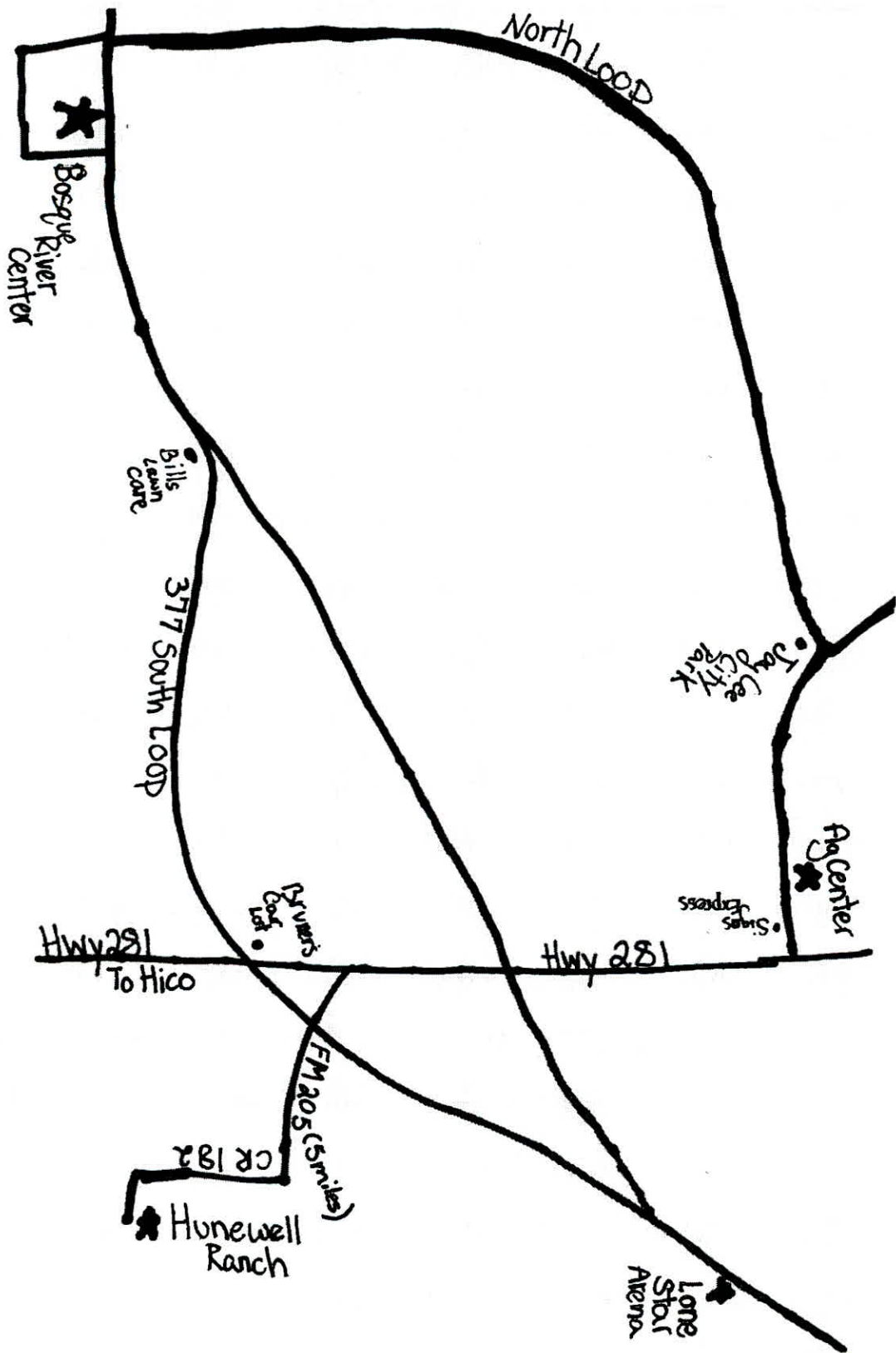

Tarleton Invitational Information

EVENT REGISTRATION:

- Events will be held on **Thursday April 6th, 2017.**
- **Entry Deadline:** All entries completed prior to **11:59 P.M. Sunday, March 26th**, are \$12.00 per contestant. Tarleton will have Clay collect entry fees for the CDE's as a result of our great experiences previous years. This will allow you to request one check from your school to cover all the entries you make this spring. In an effort to simplify matters for you and your business office, **all payments** will be made to **Clay Ewell Educational Services**. Entry fees will **NOT** be accepted at Tarleton, and checks made out to "TSU" will be returned. Look at Clay's site for more information on this! **Entries or CHANGES completed AFTER 11:59 P.M. Sunday March 26th are \$24.00 per contestant. NO EXCEPTIONS!**
- You may enter a **MAX of 5** contestants per event. **Fees will NOT be reimbursed when this maximum has been exceeded, nor will the extra contestant(s) be allowed to participate.**
- Entries are **NOT** transferable from one event to another event **AFTER** the entry deadline. Changes will require **LATE** entries at the appropriate fee.
- **ENTRY FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE!**

PRE-EVENT CHECK-IN:

- Early check-in will be held from 5:30-7:00 P.M. Wednesday evening April 5th, at the Bosque River Shopping Center (2900 W. Washington St.), for those in town early and wanting to pick up their packets. See the attached Registration Map for more details on the location.

Check-in will be April 6th from 6:00 to 7:30 A.M., at Bosque River Shopping Center (2900 W. Washington St.).

- All events are scheduled to begin at **8:30 A.M.** or as soon thereafter as superintendents feel all contestants are present.
- *******In an effort to speed the process and reduce traffic congestion PLEASE send only **ONE** vehicle per school to the packet pick up. Arrange your schools **rendezvous** point to distribute lapel cards and etc. at an **alternate** site around town as this ultimately helps EVERYONE.

TRANSPORTATION:

Teachers will need to arrange for contestants transportation to the event sites **AFTER** teams are checked in and prior to 8:30 A.M. All contestants will be required to have their lapel card before being allowed to participate.

When taking contestants to Hunewell Ranch, make sure that it is your **LAST** drop off as buses will **NOT** be allowed to leave until after 9:30 A.M.! When dropping contestants at the Ag Center please continue to enter from the **SOUTH** and exit to the **NORTH**. This is necessary to improve traffic flow and prevent gridlock which many of you have experienced in the past.

SCORING/ TABULATION:

You will need to furnish the appropriate scan sheet for your contestants. Scan sheets are available from Clay Ewell Educational Services at WWW.JUDGINGCARD.COM Ensure that your contestants have your FFA number **bubbled** correctly or they will not appear on your result summary. Pre-bubbled sheets are available from Ewell and Associates for a small surcharge should you desire them.

RESULTS:

Results will be announced in **Wisdom Gym at 3:00 P.M.** The 20 high individuals in each event will be recognized.

- Coaches' awards courtesy of the Stephenville Chamber of Commerce will be announced and presented to the winners in **attendance**.
- Invitational CDE Scholarships of \$1,000 will be awarded to the school accumulating the most points from their 5 students weighted by participation in each contest.
- A \$2,000 TSU Sweepstakes Scholarship will be awarded to the school whose contestants earn the most points from all contests weighted for participation.

SCHOLARSHIPS:

*****Teachers-** you will be allowed to select the scholarship winner(s) from your chapter.

However the rules are:

1. **Only one** event scholarship/student
2. Student selected must meet Tarleton Admission Criteria
3. Student must **MAJOR** in a discipline within the College of Agricultural and Environmental Sciences EXCEPT- ENR winners may major in a Biological Science Program (2) **Ag Sales and Marketing Plan** may major in a Business Program.
4. Student must enroll in one of 3 hour course offered by a department within the College(s)

The Sweepstakes recipient must meet the above criteria and will be awarded \$1,000.00 in the Fall of 2017 and \$1,000.00 in the Spring of 2018 provided they maintain academic standards.

These scholarships must be used in **2017-2018** academic school year. **They do NOT carry forward!**
