**RECEIVE AND FILE ANNUAL REPORT OF THE
CALIFORNIA CHILDREN AND FAMILIES COMMISSION
FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024/2025 AND CONDUCT A PUBLIC HEARING**

SUMMARY OF REQUEST

Receive and file the California Children and Families Commission (First 5 California) 2024/2025 Annual Report and conduct a public hearing pursuant to the California Children and Families Act, as required by California Health and Safety Code section 130140(h).

BACKGROUND

The annual report provides an overview of the California Children and Families Commission structure, vision, mission and goals, priority areas, signature programs, program results, and accomplishments.

March 11, 2026: A copy of the FY 2024/2025 State Commission Annual Report is provided to Commissioners as part of the meeting packet and is available for public review on the Commission's website. The report also features highlights from local county commissions. Riverside County highlights are included on pages 83 and 84. These pages reflect Riverside's focus on strengthening prevention infrastructure—embedding HealthySteps in pediatric practice; aligning Prop 10, CalWORKs, and Medi-Cal home visiting; leveraging the County's START system to reach families earlier; scaling Quality Start and workforce scholarships; and using shared dashboards and continuous quality improvement to prevent harm and measure systems change.

February 23, 2026: The Fiscal Year 2024/2025 State Commission Annual Report was posted to the First 5 Riverside County website (rccfc.org/impact) for public review.

The California Children and Families Act (Proposition 10) requires that:

1. The State Children and Families Commission shall prepare a written report that consolidates, summarizes, analyzes, and comments on the annual audits and reports submitted by all 58 county commissions for the preceding fiscal year. The report must be transmitted to the Governor, the Legislature, and each county commission.
2. Each county commission must conduct at least one public hearing on each annual report distributed by the state commission.

RECOMMENDED ACTION

That the Commission:

1. Conduct a public hearing in compliance with California Health and Safety Code section 130140(h); and
2. Receive and file the report (no Commission approval or adoption is required).
