Student Achievement: aReading (1*,2-12)





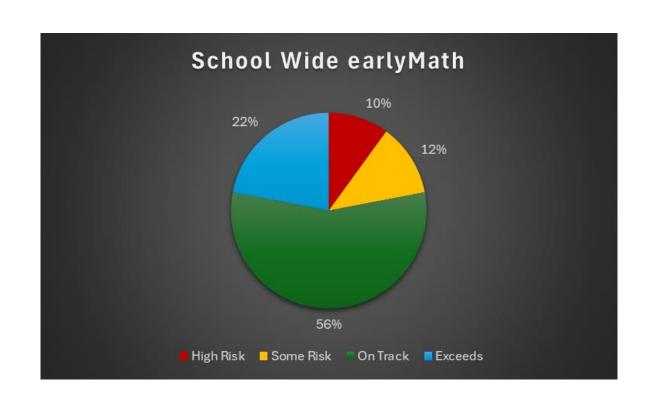
