#### Monitor out-of-school activities

**Examples:** Set limits on TV watching, checking in with kids when parents are not home, arranging afterschool activities and supervised care


# IMUNIZATIONS


The immunization exclusion date for non compliant students is Wednesday, February 17th!


You must provide documentation of the updated shot record or exemption module completion form prior to this date. If you do not your student will be excluded from school till one of those forms are obtained.
