**Background Information:** The Texas Education Code §39.306, requires each district’s Board of Trustees to publish an annual report that includes the TAPR report, campus performance objectives, financial reports, district accreditation status, special education determination status, a report of violent or criminal incidents, student performance in secondary institutions, and progress towards meeting House Bill 3 (HB3) goals. The Board of Trustees shall hold a hearing for public discussion of the report, and they shall disseminate the report within the district.

An overview will be presented of the highlights of the 2024-2025 Celina ISD Annual Report. This presentation fulfills the requirement for a public hearing and discussion to be held within 90 days of receipt of the report. According to guidance, the posting requirements for this public hearing have been met. Copies of the report will be posted on the district website and available for viewing at the Central Administration Office.
