5. Largest factory Fuel Tanks w/ additional 100 gallon fuel tank in truck bed.
6. Heavy-Duty trailer hauling package.
7. Integrated factory trailer brake controller w/Heavy-Duty braking package.
8. Spare tire & carrier (winch type mounted under the rear frame).
9. Heavy-Duty electric brake control.
