## A RESOLUTION OF THE CLACKAMAS COMMUNITY COLLEGE, CLACKAMAS COUNTY, OREGON, AUTHORIZING THE COLLEGE TO UTILIZE AN OMNIA COOPERATIVE CONTRACT FOR A LIMITED-DURATION SENIOR PROJECT MANAGER TO LEAD THE ELLUCIAN COLLEAGUE SAAS MIGRATION

WHEREAS, Clackamas Community College has made the strategic decision to modernize its core Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) and Student Information System (SIS) by migrating from its on-premises Ellucian Colleague system to the Ellucian SaaS (Software as a Service) platform; and

**WHEREAS**, this migration is a mission-critical, campus-wide initiative impacting Student Services, Finance, HR, and other administrative and academic support functions, requiring dedicated leadership to ensure success; and

**WHEREAS**, the scope, scale, and complexity of this project necessitate an experienced Senior Project Manager to oversee vendor coordination, project controls, stakeholder engagement, change management, and readiness activities, ensuring a secure, efficient, and timely transition; and

**WHEREAS**, failure to provide strong project leadership would increase the risk of service disruptions, misalignment, and budget overruns, thereby impacting students, staff, and the College's long-term operational stability.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

**SECTION 1.** The Board of Education authorizes the college to enter into a cooperative contract utilizing OMNIA Partners to hiring a limited-duration (2 years) Senior Project Manager consultant to lead the Ellucian Colleague SaaS migration project, not to exceed \$900,000.

**SECTION 2.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the Clackamas Community College Board of Education.
