
I would like to officially request the recognition of Eagle Pass High School Band Member Santiago Villarreal. Santiago is an Area student selected to perform in a Texas All-State Music Ensemble. About 70,000 students initially enter the TMEA All-State competitive process. 1,875 students are selected to perform in 18 All-State ensembles. All-State performances were held as part of the TMEA Clinic/Convention, February 12–15, 2025. Over 30,000 people from Texas and around the world attended the convention that features over 300 workshops, 100 performances, and 600 exhibiting companies and higher education institutions. This is the nation's largest music educator's convention. Santiago was chosen for this prestigious honor through a competitive process held this year across the state at District, Region, and Area levels. Santiago plays Bass Clarinet at school under the direction of David M. Solis, who is a member of the Texas Music Educators Association, a 20,400+ member organization headquartered in Austin. This is Santiago's first time performing as a member of a TMEA All-State organization.
