TOPIC: Approval to Purchase i-Ready Diagnostic & Instructional Licenses

RECOMMENDATION:

Move that the Board of Education of the Livonia Public Schools School District approve the purchase of the i-Ready online adaptive diagnostic assessment and targeted instructional licenses from Curriculum Associates, for a total of \$112,302.60. This total includes reduced cost per license, for a savings of \$32,405.40.

RATIONALE:

The purchase of i-Ready Diagnostic and Instruction will provide all kindergarten through eighth grade students with a State of Michigan approved assessment. The diagnostic results provide teachers with their students' strengths and weaknesses in reading and math. This purchase includes targeted instructional licenses to be used to support students who are in Livonia Virtual or Student Success classes.

BUDGETARY INFORMATION:

The funding for this purchase will come from Academic Services Department funds, which will be supported by any grants available from the State of Michigan.
