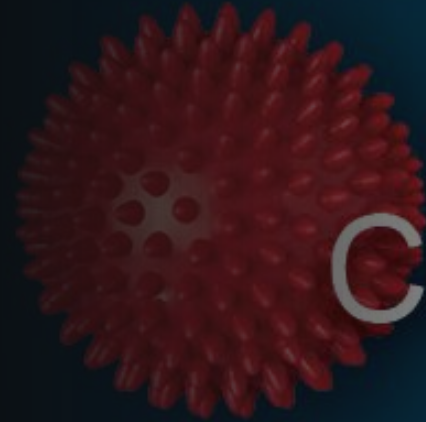

COVID-19 Waivers

Nationwide Waiver to Allow Non-congregate Feeding in the Child Nutrition Programs - EXTENSION (Expiration extended from June 30 to August 31)

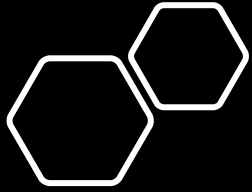
Nationwide Waiver to Allow Meal Service Time Flexibility in the National School Lunch Program, School Breakfast Program, and Child and Adult Care Food Program - EXTENSION (Expiration extended from June 30 to August 31)

Nationwide Waiver to Allow Meal Pattern Flexibility in the Child Nutrition Programs - EXTENSION (Expiration extended from May 31 to June 30)

Nationwide Waiver to Allow Parents and Guardians to Pick Up Meals for Children - EXTENSION (Expiration extended from June 30 to August 31)

While TDA has notified USDA that the agency will enact the above Nationwide Waivers, we are analyzing the requirements associated with each to establish the process for implementation. Refer to our latest FAQ for the latest guidance on the latest waivers.

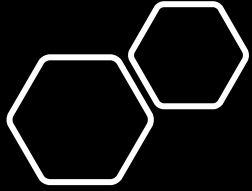


Pandemic- EBT (P-EBT)



Because of school closures from COVID-19, Texas received approval from the U.S. Department of Agriculture to provide more than **\$1 billion** in pandemic food benefits to families with children that have temporarily lost access to free or reduced-price school meals.

Pandemic- EBT (P-EBT)



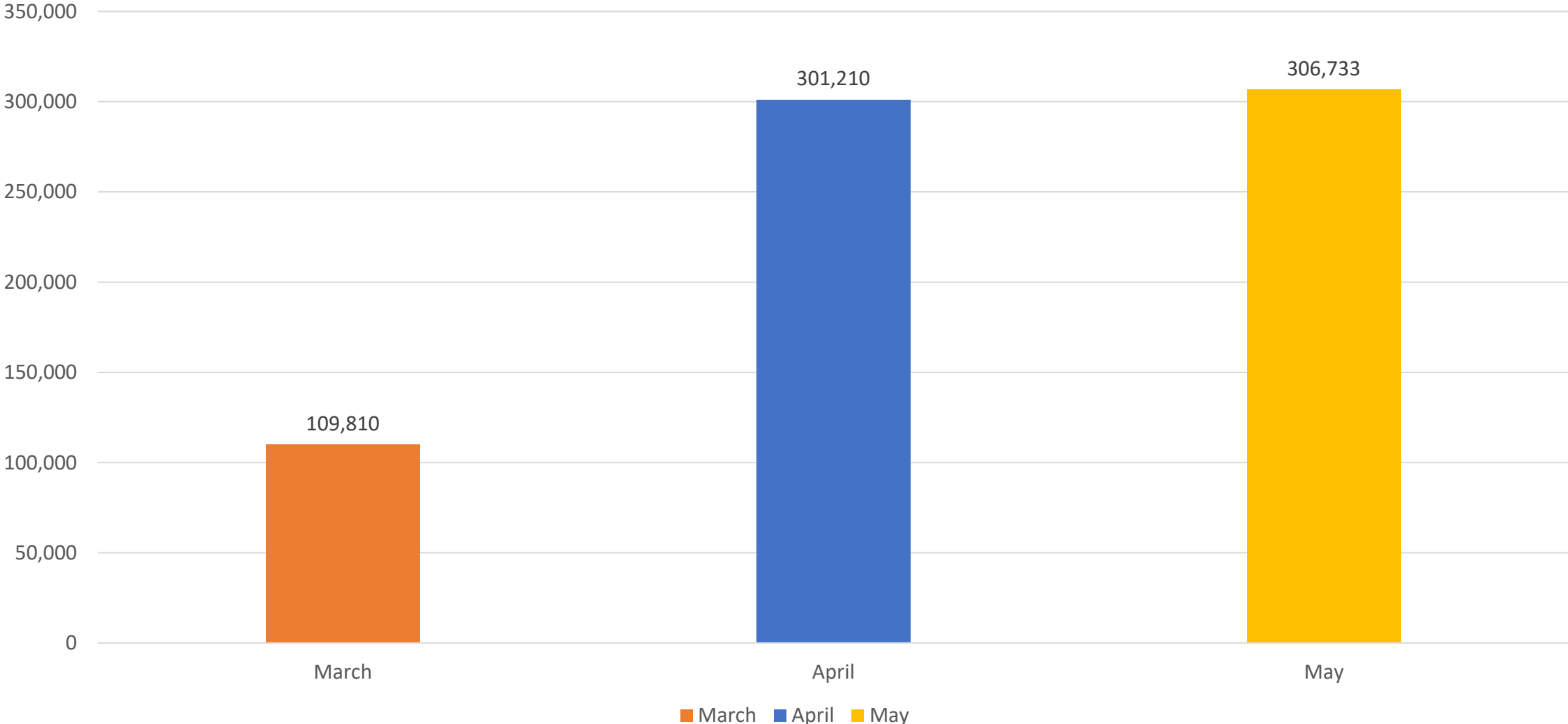
Who is Eligible for P-EBT?

P-EBT is for children 5-18 years old who received SNAP food benefits for the month of March 2020 and children up to 21 years old who are certified for free or reduced-price meals at school in Texas during the 2019-20 school year.

How much money will I receive?

P-EBT is \$285 per eligible child. This amount is based on the average number of days schools are closed for the remainder of the school year.
