Waskom High School Board Proposal Monday, October 11th, 2010

- Under our current guidelines and policies, the possibility exists that a student graduating on the minimum diploma plan could graduate with honors in the top 10% of the class.
- Students on the minimum plan are not required to meet the new 4 x 4 curriculum requirements and are not required to have the same number of credits to graduate, and therefore, are not required to take the number of courses or the level of courses required to graduate on either the recommended plan or the distinguished achievement plan.
- Since this does possibly affect college acceptance, as well as, scholarship monies that may accompany graduating with honors, we would like to make the following proposal:
 - In order to graduate with top 10% honors from Waskom High School, students must graduate on either the Recommended Diploma Plan or the Distinguished Achievement Plan.
- We have talked to representatives from TASB, as well as, the attorneys that have advised us on the wording of the proposal as to not include or exclude any particular student group.

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
