Update 1: EQUIPMENT

- Every teacher has received their laptops – almost 500 distributed during July and August
- Older equipment is being evaluated and repurposed
- Julian/Brooks have 5 carts of Netbooks (120 each) ready for use.
- Mac labs have been set up for Mac and Windows 7 usage
- LCDs and carts are being set up for building use
- New log-in structure in place for local and network saving
- IEP stations will be set up in the near future
- Average of 350 wireless connections daily.

Update 2: PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

- 390 Teachers have taken District's official summer Dell training.
- Teachers also received brief walkthrough at the time of pickup for information about usage and log-in process.
- Offering Dell training during September for remaining staff who did not make the summer sessions.
- Offering Google Docs workshops at all schools.
- Offering Google Calendars workshops at all schools.
- Planning building and U97 workshops related to curricular integration and ePortfolios

Update 3: District-wide Professional Development: GOALS & OBJECTIVES

Goal: The school district will integrate technology at all levels throughout the curriculum.

Objective: Teachers will use technology in one lesson in each curricular area per week

Goal: The school district will train teachers about NETS.

Objective: Teachers will effectively model and apply NETS as they design, implement, and assess learning experiences for students.

Goal: The school district will integrate technology using NETS throughout the curriculum.

Objective: The students will become proficient in skills taught from NETS.
