The District is organized as a Unit School District, serving grades kindergarten through twelve. In addition, the District serves special education students from age 3 to 21 as required by the laws of the State of Illinois and the United States Government. The district also operates an early childhood at-risk program funded by the State.

The District operates with a variety of student centers to meet the needs of the various populations within the School District. Those operations vary from time to time based upon available space in existing facilities in the needs of the community.
