SUBJECT: AMENDMENT TO CURRENT FOREIGN EXCHANGE WAIVER

BOARD GOAL: All students will achieve educational excellence.

All systems in Keller ISD will be effective, efficient, and accountable

in support of the district's mission.

FISCAL NOTE: None

Background Information:

- 1. Keller ISD requested and received a waiver to limit the number of Foreign Exchange students to no more than fifteen in any one year.
- 2. Since that time the District has closed two high schools to in-district transfers.
- 3. The District has a policy to limit the number of Foreign Exchange students to no more than five per high school.
- 4. The Board directed the administration to not accept Foreign Exchange students at any district high school that is not open to in-district transfers.
- 5. After receiving a complaint from a foreign exchange organization about the implementation of this policy, which for 2006-2007 will limit Foreign Exchange students to less than the fifteen requested in the waiver, TEA informed the district that it could not limit the number to less than fifteen without approval of an amended waiver.

Administrative Considerations:

- 1. Because of continued rapid growth and overcrowding at two of the district's high schools, the district needs to limit the number of Foreign Exchange students that the District is required to place.
- 2. There are currently five approved Foreign Exchange students placed for 2006-2007 with a possible three additional who have requested admission.
- 3. Until the amended waiver is approved by TEA, the District must continue to accept students up to the fifteen student limit in the current waiver.
- 4. District policy (FD local) must be amended to comply with the TEA interpretation of the waiver limit and to address how the amended waiver will be addressed.

The administration recommends that the Board of School Trustees approve the amendment to the current Foreign Exchange Student Waiver as presented.
