
School Improvement Plan

SLO Goal

- 70% of the students in grades 2 5 will reach fluent proficiency by completing the set number of math facts for their grade level in addition, subtraction (2 - 5) and multiplication (4/5).
 - 93% of the students met the goal of timed assessments in Addition, Subtraction, and Multiplication. With a goal of 70% reaching proficiency, this goal has been exceeded well.



Annual Goal:

- 70% of students in TES grades 2-5 will meet or exceed the national average on the MAPS Math Assessment by Spring 2015.
 - 61.5% of the students were within the National Average
 - Fall 50.5% were below grade level. Now only 38.5% are

Annual Goal:

- The Building Leadership Team will analyze PALS, MAPS, Skyward, and SWIS data three times this year to learn the process of using data to inform instruction and to develop understandings around data gathering and analyzing.
 - The building leadership team met nearly every month. The focus was on data analysis, but it was also on building needs and communication.



Annual Goal:

- Begin implementation of the Rtl process.
 - Mitch, Jim Jaeger, and I met monthly much of the school year. We developed a process to be followed for Rtl for upcoming years.
 - A process has been developed and children with special needs have been identified.
