Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports (PBIS)

Duchesne Elementary School will establish school wide procedures for all students and staff in the school. The goal is to create an environment where positive behaviors are taught and reinforced throughout the school day and year. This will be done by using positive strategies, establishing a positive environment, teaching social and emotional skills, reinforcing positive behavior, and responding to inappropriate behavior.

Tier I:

- Establishing three to five positive school rules.
- Establishing three to five positive classroom rules.
- Create and post a daily classroom schedule for students.
- Use positive teacher language in the classroom.
- Use positive staff language in the school.
- Continually reinforcing positive behavior.
- Use the Second Step program with fidelity in each classroom.
- Award Eagle Feathers cards to students for positive actions.
- Weekly drawing of Eagle Feather cards for prizes.
- Opportunities for each child to celebrate their individual progress (data binders).
- Classroom celebrations for achieving goals.
- Use collaborate problem solving when appropriate.
- Social-emotional learning will take place in the classroom using the SecondStep program.
- School social worker and student success coach teaching students about and how to utilize the Zones of Regulation

Tier II:

- Wellness center visits as needed.
- School social worker and student success coach will work with small groups or individual or individual students to review rules, behavior, and or social issues.
- Bullyology groups as needed ran by the school social worker or student success coach.
- Frequent check-in for individual students as needed.

Tier III:

- Behavior contracts as needed.
- Use of behavior tracking charts.
