Date: September 24, 2024 Re: RIHS Cafeteria Flooring

The cafeteria flooring at Rock Island High School needs to be replaced and properly reinstalled. During renovations at the High School it was discovered that the appropriate moisture barrier was not utilized and is causing the flooring to move. To ensure the appropriate remediation, it is recommended that the Board of Education approve a proposal by Legat Architects to provide architectural services not to exceed \$16,000 for this project. This would include the construction documents, bidding, and completion of the project. The overall project is expected to cost approximately \$225,000. Staff applied for the School Maintenance Project Grant to assist in the funding, and once this project is awarded, Board of Education approval will be required.

Total Investment: Not to Exceed \$16,000
