Greetings from the Foley Public Schools Activities Department,

## **Company Merger**

Two major companies that Activities Departments across the state use have merged. Arbiter, which is used for assigning and paying officials and rSchools, used to create contracts and schedules, have joined forces. Parents and community members should not notice many changes from their end of things aside from a few graphic and esthetic differences. The companies have been working hard to roll over stored data from rSchools over to Arbiter and registration for Fall Activities should be ready to roll August 1st.

### Pool Use

Fall Activities begin August 11th. The summer construction project will not be wrapped up by that time. Adjustments will be made in order to ensure that all activities are able to practice and prepare for their seasons. The most challenging will be Swimming and Diving. Contact has been made with Milaca, Becker, and St. Cloud State about utilizing their pools in order for the Foley Team to practice. Transportation of the athletes will also need to be arranged but a solid plan for the first month of the Swimming and Diving Season will be in place prior to the August 11th start date.

### Fall Activities Meeting
