







A Sense of Belonging Why this Goal?





A strong sense of school belonging is consistently linked to better **academic achievement**, **attendance**, **motivation**, **and engagement**. Students who feel they belong are more likely to participate, persist, and succeed academically.

Belonging—the feeling of being accepted, valued, and included—is a basic human need that underpins learning and development.

Supportive teacher-student relationships and positive peer connections are the strongest predictors of belonging.


