EXECUTIVE SUMMARY/BACKGROUND:

Head Start Performance Standard 1302(a) *Purpose*. A program must ensure all *staff*, consultants, and contractors engaged in the delivery of program services have sufficient knowledge, training and experience, and competencies to fulfill the roles and responsibilities of their positions and to ensure high-quality service delivery in accordance with the program performance standards. A program must provide ongoing training and professional development to support staff in fulfilling their roles and responsibilities.: (2) *Education management*. As prescribed in section [648A\(a\)\(2\)\(B\)\(i\)](#) of the Act, a program must ensure staff and consultants that serve as education managers or coordinators, including those that serve as curriculum specialists, have a baccalaureate or advanced degree in early childhood education or a baccalaureate or advanced degree and equivalent coursework in early childhood education with early education teaching experience.
