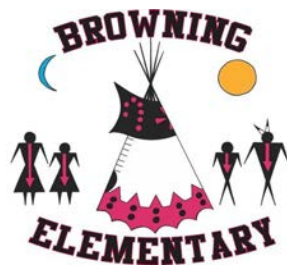

Instructional Coaches Report by Arlene Wippert and Melissa Henderson

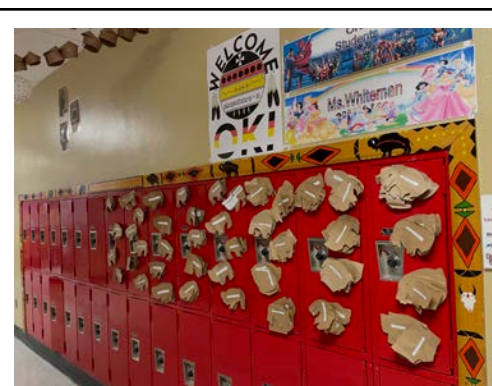
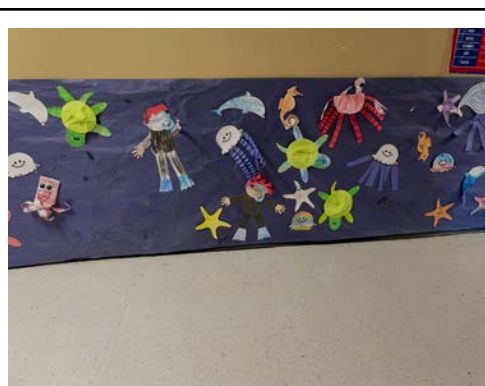
