Statewide Assessments

PEAKS

- The LPSD PEAKS assessment window is tentatively April 12-16. Make-up assessments will take place the following week.
- The Alaska Science Assessment is being replaced by the PEAKS Science Assessment.
- There are two changes in the administration of the new test. It will be administered to grade 5 instead of grade 4. It will continue to be administered to grades 8 and 10. The Alaska Science Assessment was given in one part. The PEAKS Science Assessment is given in 3 parts.
- The 2021 administration of the PEAKS Science Assessment will be a field test. All students in those grade levels will take the assessment. However, they will not receive scores. Instead the results will be used to calibrate answers.

NAEP- The National Assessment of Education Progress

- Igiugig and Port Alsworth were selected to participate in the NAEP assessment in 2021.
