

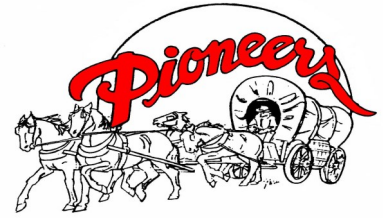

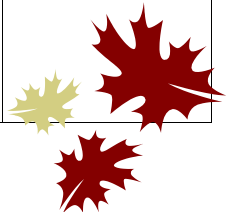

This year Williams Elementary School will hold our annual Jog-a-thon in the Spring of 2020. Money that is raised through the Jog-a-thon help to fund Classroom Field Trips, Special Programs, our Annual Holiday Play, Playground Equipment, Extended Learning Programs, and Materials for all grades throughout the school year.

Students who participate in the Jog-a-thon raise donations and pledges for the amount of laps they run in a one hour time period. Visitors and Online Volunteer Application

Parents, as well as community members, are always welcome to visit or volunteer in the classes at Williams Elementary School. Please make prior arrangements with the teacher and office before coming to volunteer. **School Volunteers MUST fill out a Volunteer Online Application**. A background check will be done and could take up to two weeks to process. The Application is available online at our school website at www.threerivers.k12.or.us. Just click on the New Volunteer Application under the School News Tab. If you do not have a computer and need help filling out the application, there is a computer available at the school for this purpose.

Parents, visitors, and volunteers must check in with the office and have a **VISITORS PASS** while on the campus during school hours. If you are picking up or dropping off your student (even for early field trips) always do so through the front office. Please do not enter through the side entrance at anytime during the school day. For the protection of students and the prevention of disruption, **all visitors/volunteers must enter and sign in at the office and pick up a visitor's pass.**
