Background Information

The Labor Management Committee (LMC) met September 28 to hear renewal rates from Blue Cross Blue Shield (BCBS) for 2022. Initial renewal was coming in at 11.2%. Prior to the Sept 28 meeting Intellicents had negotiated BCBS down to 7.1%. The LMC instructed Intellicents to continue negotiations with BCBS. At the LMC meeting on Oct 5, Intellicents presented a 5% renewal. The LMC is recommending the board approve the renewal at 5%. Rates are listed below.

Note: Single and Family \$350 health insurance plans are only available to the retirees who are currently enrolled. No additional employees may enroll in those plans. Medicare Cost plan is available to retirees who reside in Aitkin, Carlton, Cook, Goodhue, Itasca, Kanabec, Koochiching, Lake, Le Suer, McLeod, Millle Lacs, Pine, Pipestones, Rice, Rock, Sibley, St. Louis, Stevens, Traverse, or Yellow Medicine Counties. The Medicare Supplement (Plan N) is available outside those areas.
