In pursuit of excellence, the district will foster a positive and welcoming environment that encourages parent and community partnerships to achieve success for all our students.

Purpose of Report

This report shows the attendance percentages for each grade level for the sixth grading cycle (April 18, 2017 – June 1, 2017). Also, the overall attendance for the 2016-2017 school year is provided. Finally, there is attendance comparison for the four years prior.

Objectives

- District-wide totals based on number of students in each grade level.
- Attendance figures are taken from the PEIMS report
- Attendance figures are based on 32 instructional days (sixth cycle)
- Attendance for the school year is based on 177 instructional days

Operational Impact

The attendance figures from PEIMS are used to determine the district ADA.

Results

- The total attendance percentage for the Denton ISD for Cycle 6 is 95.95%.
- The lowest total attendance average is for 12th grade students at 92.42% followed by 11th grade students at 94.45%.
- The highest attendance average is in grade 5 at 97.16% followed by grade 4 at 96.89.
- The district EOY total for 2016-2017 is 96.08%.
- 6th cycle reflects testing days and final exam days
