NSBSD Strategic Plan Goal:

1.5 Multiple Pathways- Implement career learning and alternative programs expanding educational opportunities that connect students to careers and providing multiple pathways to graduation based on student needs and interests.

NSBSD Policy Manual:

Issue Summary:

Over the past year, administration has been working on preparing the training for the pilot of the Project Lead the Way modules for elementary students. The modules focus on Science, Technology, Engineering, Mathematics (STEM) and were introduced to the Board at the February 13, 2021 school meeting. There was a slight delay for the training due to COVID restrictions and adjustments from in-person training to distance delivered training. The training is required before the modules can be implemented in the classroom to ensure that students receive the maximum benefit from the experience.
