The Extended School Year (ESY) Program

Focus

- Approx. 65 entering grades PreK-6 students with identified special needs, invited through PPT process

Curriculum

- Determined based on IEP needs

Timing

- July 5-28, Monday-Thursday (plus Fri., July 9), between 8-10, or 9-12, depending on student needs

Funding Source

- FY 2023 operating budget

The Learning Academy

Focus

- Approx. 100 entering grades 1-6 students identified as having learning loss in literacy and/or mathematics, invited through data analysis process, or parent request if room available; social-emotional engagement in a healthy, fun context is also included

Curriculum

- Determined based on key literacy & math standards

Timing

- July 5-28, Monday-Thursday (plus Fri., July 8), between 10-12:30

Funding Source

- ARP ESSER grant

The Multilingual Learner Summer Program

Focus

- Approx. 15 entering grades K-2 students identified as being multilingual (culturally & linguistically diverse students whose native language is not English, who have another language spoken in their home, or who come from an environment where a language other than English has had a significant impact on the individual's level of English language proficiency)

Curriculum

- Determined based on CELP (CT English Language Proficiency) Standards

Timing

- July 5-8 (entering grades 1-2) / July 11-14 (entering K), between 8-10

Funding Source

- ARP ESSER grant

The Summer Enrichment Program (SEP)

Focus

- Over 60 exceptional summer experiences for our Beecher children, including:
 - “So You’re Coming to Kindergarten!”
 - “Summer of STEAM”
 - “Playing with Plants”
 - “Guitar Introduction”
 - “Open Art Studio”
