203.2 ORDER OF THE REGULAR SCHOOL BOARD MEETING

I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to ensure consistency in the order of business at regular school board meetings of Independent School District #182, Crosby-Ironton Public Schools.

II. GENERAL STATEMENT OF POLICY

It is the policy of the school board to consider matters that come before it in a consistent and orderly manner.

III. ORDER

- A. The school board shall conduct an orderly school board meeting. The school board will, at all regular school board meetings, follow an agenda order similar to:
 - 1. Call to order.
 - 2. Recognition of Visitors.
 - 3. Board discussion on items.
 - 4. Approval of Agenda.
 - 5. Approval of prior meeting minutes.
 - 6. Written and oral administrative and committee Reports.
 - 7. Financial reports by consent agenda.
 - 8. Personnel items by consent agenda.
 - 9. Action items.
 - 10. Public comments.
 - 11. Adjournment.
- B. Items in this order may be considered as part of a consent agenda.
- C. The school board may depart from the order of business with the consent of the majority of members present.
