Homedale Board of Trustees,

Spring Sports seasons of Track, Golf, Tennis, Baseball, and Softball are off and running. There has been a strong turnout this spring for each of our spring sports which is exciting to see. 141/344 \approx 41% of our students participating in a spring sport.

Track- We have 45 athletes out for track so far this season. This is up from last season by about 12 athletes. There is a lot of excitement down at the track this spring with the middle school numbers up as well. We are hosting our first and only home track meet of the year this coming Friday the 10th of April.

Tennis- We have 30 athletes out for tennis so far this season. This is up from last season by 10 athletes. We have some returning state competitors that should make for a strong season for our tennis team.

Golf- We have 9 athletes out for golf this spring the same amount of athletes as we did last season. In the first couple of Golf matches our team has finished 2nd place. They have a good chance of qualifying once again for the state tournament in May.

Baseball- The Varsity Baseball team is off to a great start with a 7-2 record. They play rival Fruitland as well as Emmett this week April 7th and April 10th. It should be an exciting season for baseball as they look to return to the state tournament again this season. The JV team is currently 3-3-1 on the season with lots of young talent on the team. We have 29 athletes out for Baseball this spring up 3 from last spring.

Softball- The Varsity Softball team is off to an amazing start. Currently the team is undefeated on the season at 12-0 with a clean sweep at the ISG Softball tournament over in Meridian/Boise. JV team sits at 6-3 overall. This week is a big week for Softball as well as they take on Fruitland and Emmett April 7th and 10th. This spring we have 28 athletes out for softball up 1 from last spring.

Projects- Baseball backstop, and dugouts are close to being finished and should be usable this next week.

- Football Scoreboard is in its final art approval stages.
- Weight Room Windows (Senior project by Kyler Landa) is in its final stage as we simply have the installation of the windows left to do. It has been a big undertaking on his part and much appreciated! He has helped raise over \$4,000.
