CURRICULUM & INSTRUCTION

As we wind down for the year, we still have plenty to do. In addition to teaching until the last day, we've had our year end district assessment as well as the state assessment SBAC and MSAA.

Plans are already underway and finalized for preparing for next year. SBE, Leadership Week (instructional planning), and Principal/Coach planning time.

Summer school will have a new coordinator this year, we welcome Katie Boyce (upon board approval) and she is excited to begin.
