Over the years, the chapter has provided direct student, family, and campus level support aligned with Alpha Kappa Alpha's International Programs and the evolving needs of the Cedar Hill Independent School District (CHISD) community.</p> <p>These collective efforts have included participating in initiatives such as the Cedar Hill ISD Back-to-School Rally, distribution of backpacks and school supplies, youth leadership and enrichment, campus lunch support, food drives, care</p>				

packages, and coordinated community relief efforts, each designed to uplift scholars, families, and educators with dignity, care, and impact.

Over the past year alone, they have volunteered their time and talents at Plummer Elementary's Boo Bash, the HBCU college fair, the CHHSD Voter Registration Drive, and the CHISD School Board Candidate Forum. They also offered emergency support and donations for a student impacted by a house fire, held a faculty and staff appreciation lunch during STAAR testing, conducted a Black History Month book drive for Bessie Coleman Middle School, and awarded scholarships to CHHS and Collegiate High School graduating seniors.

In addition, over the past ten years they have also invested an estimated \$10,000 to CHISD scholars through the Pearls of the Ivy Foundation, Incorporated, the philanthropic arm connected to the Upsilon Lambda Omega Chapter. The Foundation administers scholarship programs that intentionally support students graduating from Cedar Hill High School and other Best Southwest area schools, reinforcing access to higher education and long-term success.
