ACCOUNTING: ACTIVITY FUNDS MANAGEMENT CFD (LOCAL)

STUDENT FUNDS	The Superintendent or designee shall ensure that a student activi- ties account is maintained to manage all class funds, organization funds, and any other funds collected from students for a school-re- lated purpose. Receipts shall be issued by the principal or desig- nee for all funds prior to their deposit into the appropriate District account at the District depository.	
FIDUCIARY RESPONSIBILITY	The principal and sponsor shall be responsible for the proper ad- ministration of student funds in accordance with state and local aw, District-approved accounting practices and procedures, and the TEA <i>Financial Accountability System Resource Guide</i> . Student activity funds shall be included in the annual audit of the District's fiscal accounts. [See CFC]	
USE AND EXPENDITURE	Funds collected by student groups shall be used only for purposes authorized by the organization or upon approval of the sponsor. The principal or designee shall approve all disbursements. All funds raised by student organizations must be expended for the benefit of the students.	
CAMPUS ACTIVITY FUND	The principal shall be authorized to expend funds from the campus administrative activity fund to be used for activities of the students, faculty, staff, or campus.	
APPROVAL	Approval from the immediate supervisor or designee shall be obtained prior to a disbursement being made to the principal.	
CARRYOVER FUNDS	All funds shall be left in the appropriate account and each sponsor- ing group shall retain the carryover funds for the next fiscal year. If an organization ceases to function or exist, the unexpended funds of the organization shall be credited to the appropriate administra- tive activity account.	
SENIOR CLASS FUNDS	Unexpended senior class funds remaining in the class account after the class has graduated and after all outstand- ing bills have been paid shall be transferred to another stu- dent fund or to the campus activity fund:	
	1. As directed by the senior class prior to graduation or	
	2. At the discretion of the principal in the absence of a directive from the class.
