SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF DESIGN DEVELOPMENT FOR NEW ELEMENTARY SCHOOL #22

Background Information:

- On January 28, 2010, the Board of Trustees approved contracting with VLK Architects to adapt the current elementary prototype, which was developed by VLK. On April 8th, 2010 the Administration requested the School Board approve reconsidering the design of the Elementary school due to the topography of the site.
- The Architect has met with representatives from various KISD departments to receive input on the design of the new elementary school campus.
