The CTE department is requesting board approval to allow UISD to offer the following state innovative course for implementation of the Laredo College EMT pilot program at United South High School for the 2019-2020 school year:

Disaster Response – N1303011 (1 credit)

Emergency Medical Technician Basic – N1303015 (2 credits)

Laredo College Emergency Management Services EMT-Basic Program Level 1 Certificate



EMT –Basic Program

- United ISD CTE Department will be piloting the EMT-Basic Level 1 semester certificate at United South High School for the 2019-2020 school year. The level 1 certificate curriculum consists of 5 courses for a total of 16 college credit hours. A maximum of fifteen 12th grade students are allowed each year.
- After completing the curriculum, students are required to pass the national registry of EMT exam in order to be eligible for any state certification (EMT- Basic). The national certification is valid and recognized in all 50 states.

Post graduation options:

- Students can work for: private EMS companies, hospital emergency rooms, plasma centers, correctional facilities, and oil companies. Students have also used the EMT Certification to open doors in law enforcement.
- Students can continue at Laredo College for additional college credit hours towards becoming an Advanced Emergency Medical Technician or Paramedic.

TEA State Innovative Courses-Board Approval

The CTE department is requesting board approval to allow UISD to offer the following state innovative course for implementation of the EMT program.

Disaster Response – N1303011 (1 credit)

Emergency Medical Technician Basic – N1303015 (2 credits)

As per TEA:

- Innovative courses allow districts to offer state-approved courses to enable students to master knowledge, skills, and competencies not included in the essential knowledge and skills of the required curriculum as per TAC Section 74.27.
- School districts may offer any state-approved innovative courses for state elective credit only if approved by local board of trustees.
