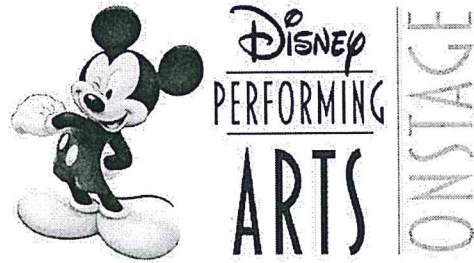




# School Board Report-Band

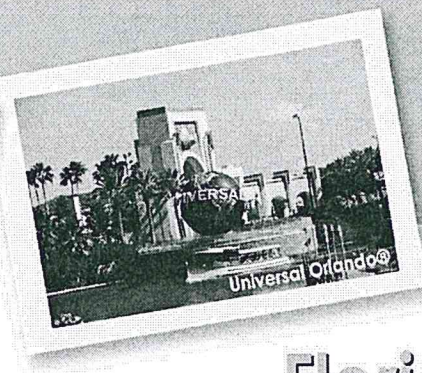
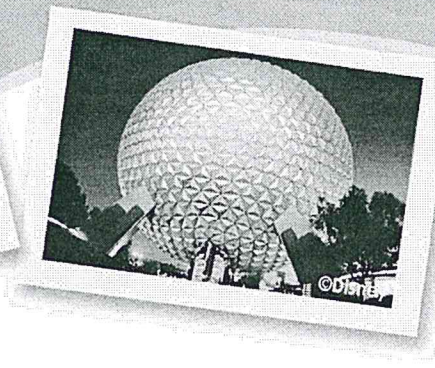
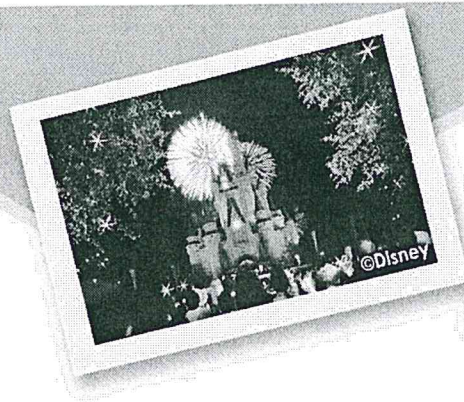
(Students will need to fundraise/pay their own way in order to go on the trip; we will need to do organized fundraisers over the course of the year)

Trailer Update: I contacted BigTex Trailers and talked with a dealer. I am waiting to hear back on whether or not the dimensions are doable along with the rear door/ramp. (The website shows basically what we currently have)

Here is a description of what I am wanting: 24 foot Enclosed Cargo trailer with 3 sturdy interior mounted shelves on both sides 12' long, 2' deep, 2' clearance between shelves with a 4" lip on each shelf to keep instruments from falling to the floor. The trailer would be 8.5' wide with extra height. It would need a rear ramp gate and an extra wide side door on the front passenger side. It would also need built in eye-hooks (20 minimum) for bungee ties, and a closet bar to hang garments on down the center aisle and across the front. Lastly, it would need interior lights.

Current dimensions are: Width-8ft, Height 7'8", Length 20'1"
